AMMENDMENTS TO BALLAST WATER MANAGEMENT CONVENTION

This Maritime Circular should be read in conjunction with Maritime Circular MC/72/17, and details amendments to the Ballast Water Management Convention, which enters into force 8 September 2017

At the recent meeting of IMO MEPC 71 amendments were approved regarding the implementation date of the requirement for vessels to comply with standard D-2 on-board Ballast Water treatment systems

This Administration has ratified the Ballast Water Management Convention, 2004 as of 30 August 2005, in order to support a phased implementation and ensure a smooth transition to the D-2 performance standard of the Convention between 2017 and 2024.

The revised implementation date for compliance with standard D-2 of the Convention is given below.

Notwithstanding the above changes for compliance with standard D-2 all parties are reminded that the compliance date for standard D-1 on ballast water exchange ballast water documentation (certification, ballast water plan and ballast water record book) remains the 8th September 2017 when the Ballast Water Convention comes into force.
